

# **MDOT, MRBA and MAPA 2016 Storm Water Training**

Thompson Engineering will be performing the Storm Water Training at specific locations throughout the state in January, February and March of 2016. For those persons that were certified in 2011, you will need to become re-certified because the certification is good for five (5) years.

There is a Memorandum of Understanding between MDOT, MRBA, MAPA and Thompson Engineering that specifies certain requirements that Thompson Engineering must follow regarding the number of attendees per class from MDOT, the construction industry and then from others. We will adhere to the following requirements:

- MDOT will be allocated 17 slots per class
- The Construction Industry will be allocated 18 slots per class
- If MDOT does not utilize their allocated slots for a particular class, the Construction Industry will have first chance at the available slots. Vice versa if the Construction Industry does not utilize their allocated slots.
- If MDOT and the Construction Industry do not use all of the available slots for a class, these slots will be made available to others such as State Aid staff, County Engineers and consultants.

The training classes will be held at the various District Office Complexes. The classes will begin at 8am and they will end before 5pm. Lunch will be provided for the attendees. As in the past, there is a test at the end of the class that the attendees must pass in order to be certified.

**The following is the training schedule for each MDOT District:**

January 12 & 13	District VII (McComb)
January 26 & 27	District VI (Hattiesburg)
February 9 & 10	District III (Yazoo City)
February 16 & 17	District V (Newton)
March 1 & 2	District II (Batesville)
March 15 & 16	District I (Tupelo)

We will begin filling the sessions starting with the first date at each location. If the first class reaches the limit, we'll start assigning persons to the second date, if there are enough persons to warrant a second class, or assign them to the closest district that has available space.

**MDOT Attendees:** Each district will submit a list of attendees for each class, not to exceed 17 attendees per class. **Construction Industry Attendees:** Please contact Sherena Sarullo at 601-899-9252 to register your employees. We will make every effort to assign your employees to the District that you request, but we can not guarantee it due to the allocation of slots. You will need to be prepared to furnish Sherena with the names of your employees that will attend a class.

**Others:** Please contact Sherena Sarullo at 601-899-9252 to be placed on a waiting list at each District. If there are available slots at the District that you request, we will use the waiting list to fill any available slots. If there are no available slots at the requested District, we will advise you where there are available slots for your consideration.

**Training Fee:** \$250.00 per attendee (Please note that once you are assigned a slot, you are responsible for that slot. If someone can not attend a class, you may substitute someone to fill the slot. Please notify Sherena Sarullo of any substitutions as soon as possible prior to the class. If the substitution is made the day of the class, you must advise the person at the registration desk of the substitution.)
